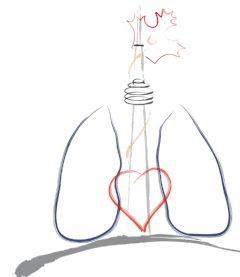

Submission:

Once submission has been completed, you will receive an email confirmation of receipt of your submission within 48hrs.

Awards:

The best abstracts in each section will be selected by the Committee for oral presentation. The following awards will be presented during the meeting:

- **The Art Slutsky Award for overall best abstract**
 - **Best clinical study poster**
 - **Best basic science poster**
 - **Best medical education poster**
 - **Best physiology poster**
 - **Best quality improvement poster**

Philosophy:

The spirit of Art Slutsky Day is to support scholarly activity related to Critical Care Medicine within the Faculty of Medicine. Submissions are encouraged from from all trainees and students with Faculty supervisors in the Division of Critical Care Medicine, and Departments of Anaesthesia, Medicine, Paediatrics and Surgery.

Abstract Instructions:

It is expected that the trainees will be the first or second author of the abstract and will be available to present their work at Slutsky Day on June 14th.

Total length of the abstract should not exceed 3,500 printable characters including punctuation and spaces.

Use a structured abstract format with headers (eg. Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions) photos and tables may be used.

Oral Presentation:

Authors of the "best in section" abstracts will be given 12 mins to present their work followed by 3 mins of questions from the audience.

Poster Presentation:

There will be a formal poster viewing session during the symposium. Please be sure that the presenting author is present at the poster for viewing and judging during these times. Be prepared to provide a brief (2 minute) oral summary of your poster to facilitate discussion and judging.

Format:

Posters will be displayed on HD screens in the Library of the University Club.
